

Annual report 2024

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The year 2024 marked a significant turning point for the Pride Business Forum Foundation – a year of fulfilled ambitions, tangible progress, and growing impact. Longenvisioned ideas became reality, and the results of our efforts were not only visible but deeply felt.

At the very beginning of the year, we launched our firstever grant programme. What had been a long-standing dream finally came to life. We provided funding to five initiatives focused on empowering LGBTQ+ people in the Czech Republic – especially in regional areas and communities facing multiple layers of marginalisation. The strong interest and feedback from the field confirmed how needed and meaningful this support truly is.

We also saw substantial progress with the LGBTQ+ Friendly Employer Award. A record number of 26 organisations applied in 2024, and thanks to the improved methodology and the involvement of external reviewers, the award is gaining credibility and weight.

Our annual conference was a resounding success, fully booked and with more than 350 participants. The programme and overall atmosphere received excellent feedback, and this interest was also reflected in a sharp increase in our visibility, particularly on LinkedIn.

However, the most important milestone in 2024 was reaching 100 member organisations. This strong and diverse group gives us legitimacy and a louder voice – and shows that LGBTQ+ inclusion is an important topic for employers in the Czech Republic. The energy and involvement of our members keep us moving forward.

2024 was an incredible year for the Pride Business Forum Foundation. The energy we gained gives us the strength to face new challenges in 2025. We believe it still makes sense to keep moving things in the right direction.

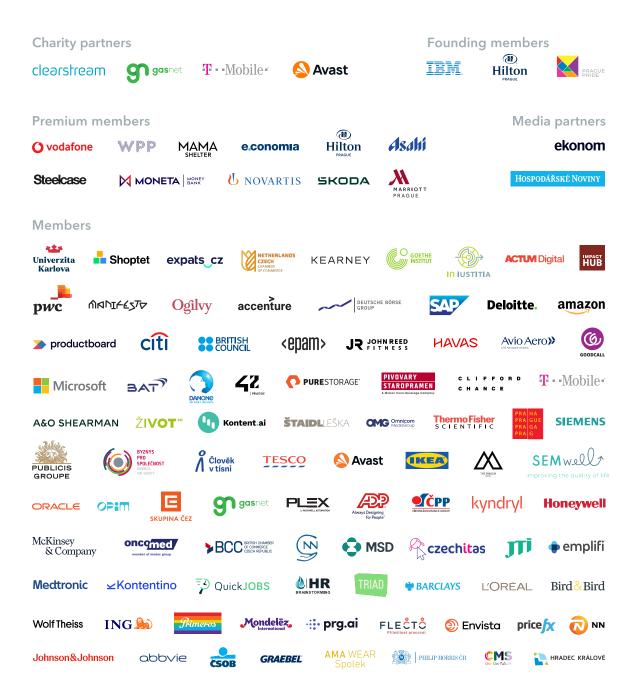

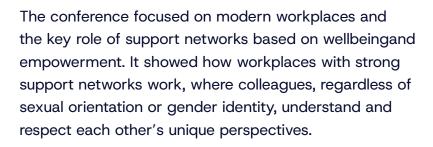


The Pride Business Forum annual conference

Grants

In 2024, we launched a grant program for local, grassroots, mostly volunteer-led organizations that help create safe spaces for LGBTQ+ people. Thanks to our charitable partners, we supported five organizations and their initiatives with smaller grants.

The supported organizations:

Trans*parent provides peer support for trans and non-binary people and raises awareness about their situation. We support their safe experience-sharing groups.

Ara Art advocates for the rights of LGBTQ+ Roma in the Czech Republic. We support their safe counselling platform Řeknu.to.

Q prostor Zlín is a volunteer group that organizes Slavex Pride and other local events. Our support helps expand their activities across the region.

Queer Geography supports an understanding of sexual and gender diversity. We fund their research on the impact of DE&I on the well-being of LGBTQ+ employees.

Pilsen Pride is a volunteer group that organizes the annual Plzeň Pride march. We support their yearly event that connects the local community.

In 2024, we organized an Employee Resource Group (ERG) networking event that brought together 150 participants. We also regularly host online meetings for our member companies focused on ERGs and communication, where we exchange experiences and support each other.

WISE project

As part of a broader European initiative, we offered our members five spots in a mentoring program for young queer professionals under 30. Over the course of 18 months, participants receive training and guidance from experienced LGBTQ+ role models from five European countries.



We welcomed a new team member to support our communication efforts. We also established **strategic partnerships** with Hospodářské noviny and the Expats.cz portal.

We saw **significant growth** on social media — our LinkedIn follower count **increased by 34.5%,** surpassing 2,000, and we even managed to double our number of Instagram followers.
